Mr. Wesbury writes a monthly column for *The American Spectator* magazine, and serves as the magazine's Economics Editor. He is a contributor to the editorial page at *The Wall Street Journal*, and is a regular co-host on CNBC's *Squawk Box*.

Mr. Wesbury is a member of the Academic Advisory Council of the Federal Reserve Bank of Chicago, and he is also an adjunct professor of economics at Wheaton College in Wheaton, IL. In 1995 and 1996, he served as Chief Economist for the Joint Economic Committee of the U.S. Congress.

Mr. Wesbury's career as an economist began in 1982 at Harris Bank in Chicago. He has also served as Vice President and Economist for The Chicago Corporation and as Senior Vice President and Chief Economist at Griffin, Kubik, Stephens & Thompson, Inc. Mr. Wesbury received an M.B.A. from Northwestern University's Kellogg Graduate School of Management, and a B.A. in Economics from the University of Montana. McGraw-Hill published Wesbury's first book, *The New Era of Wealth*, in October 1999.
