Deadline:

Applications **MUST** be postmarked by February 3, 2012. Applications postmarked after that date will not be reviewed until after all others have been reviewed and scored. Then, if space is available, the later applications will be considered.

Mailing Instructions:

Mail your application and all attachments together (in one envelope, at the same to time). Do not fax or e-mail your applications. Applications should be sent to:

Changes:

Once submitted, applications may not be changed. If you take a later ACT or SAT test, we recommend waiting until you receive the score from that last test to apply to the program. Essays may not be rewritten or letters of recommendation exchanged. There is one exception to this rule. If you receive an additional major honor or leadership position after your application has been submitted, you may send an addendum to your activities list. Please submit only leadership positions and major honors or awards. The February 3rd deadline applies for this exception.

Confirmation:

We will send you an e-mail confirming that your complete application has been received. If you don't hear from us within two weeks, please check on the status of your application (contact the Undergraduate Dean's Office at 573-882-4562). It is your responsibility to ensure that we have received the application and its attachments by the deadline.

Decision Letters:

Decision letters will be mailed on or about March 31, 2012.

Submit the following application and supporting documentation. Your original signature needs to appear on the application. Legibly print the application in either blue or black ink. Please assemble the application in the following order:

1) Application Form:

Print and complete this application. The application form will ask for information on your academic record and a list of your activities, work experience, awards, and honors. An ACT or SAT score is also required. Submit the highest, one-day test score. Do not combine the highest separate math and verbal scores from two different test dates.

2) Essay:

Write an essay on the following topic. Your essay must be typed, double-spaced, and no longer than 2 pages.

In the Harry and Ann Cornell Leadership Program, you will have the opportunity to work closely with faculty and staff in the Trulaske College of Business as well Business Professionals who come to speak to the College. If someone were to ask you about yourself and your experiences, what would you say? Why are you interested in pursuing a career in business?

3) Résumé of Leadership Experiences

Submit a résumé of activities that you have been involved in during High School. This résumé should be no more than 2 typed pages. Include experiences such as organizations you have been involved with, leadership positions you held, and activities that you participated in. Also, any awards or special recognitions you have received up to this time, and how you earned that recognition. Employment and Community Service should be included as well.

4) Letter of Recommendation:

We require a letter of recommendation. It should be written by a teacher who can comment on (1) your academic ability and (2) your personal character that make you a successful student. This letter should be given to you in a sealed envelope that is signed along the flap to be submitted with your application.

5) Transcript:

Send a copy of your official high school transcript indicating grades from your freshman year onward. The transcript should also include your class rank, when available.
