### Requirements:

- 1) Candidates **must be registered for a Summer Study Abroad Program**
- 2) UG Candidates must have a FAFSA on file with the MU Financial Aid Office to be eligible to apply.
- 3) **Must be a full-time MU student in the Trulaske College of Business with minimum cum GPA of 3.0.**
- 4) Candidates who are undergraduates must be TCOB majors. Priority will be given to students who have met the requirements for admission into the upper-level program.
- 5) Priority will be given to students with demonstrated financial need.
- 6) Students receiving the scholarship are expected to share their experience with other students through speaking/making a presentation to MU classes or seminars.

Your essay **must include** the following sections (with **section headers**) explaining the following: 1.) **Goals/Objectives:** Three specific objectives/goals (**1 paragraph each objective**) that you plan to accomplish studying abroad, 2.) **Career Goals:** Two or more career goals (**1 paragraph each goal**), and 3. **Facilitating Career Goals:** How your planned experiences from this travel abroad experience **AND** your **travel abroad objectives** will fit and facilitate your career goals (**one separate page**). **Essays will be evaluated on the basis of the thoughtfulness of these items.**

Please prepare each of the following items: 1) **application form**, 2) **essay** (from above), 3) **resume** (awards, work, etc.), 4) **unofficial transcript** from Registrar's Office (not degree audit), and 5) a separate **budget** essay of two pages that explains and advocates for your financial need (**NOT** your travel budget needs), on how this funding will make a difference for you to participate. Include your basic budget details. Please staple these five elements together as your **application packet**.
