Requirements and Application Instructions

The Business Ambassadors are an elite group of leaders who assist the Trulaske College of Business in the recruitment retention of a diverse population of high ability students.

Requirements to be an Ambassador:

1. Preferred minimum three semester commitment;
2. All business students admitted to upper level with a GPA of 3.0 are urged to apply;
3. Lower level business student with a GPA of 3.2 are urged to apply;
4. All Ambassadors are required to be in good academic standing at the time of applying as well as during the time you are an Ambassador

Selected Ambassadors are required to:

1. Attend all regularly scheduled one-hour seminars per semester on Mondays at 4:45 p.m.
2. Contribute a minimum of 24 regular hours of service per year or 12 hours per semester (recruiting/public relations events, prospective student visits to campus, telephoning prospective students, representing the Trulaske College of Business at various events, etc).
3. View commitment to Trulaske Business Students Ambassadors as top priority.

The attached application form and letter of recommendation must be returned to the Undergraduate Programs Office in 111 Cornell Hall by October 9th, 2009 at 4:00 p.m. The recommendation form should be completed by a faculty or staff member or employer. Business academic advisors may NOT serve as references. Your recommendation form should be confidential and returned in a sealed envelope as part of the complete application packet. Those candidate who are chosen to be interviewed will be notified via MU campus email.
