The Allan L. Bridgford, Jr. Scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman student pursuing a degree from MU's Robert J. Trulaske, Sr. College of Business. Only one scholarship is awarded each year. The primary qualifications are academic achievement & financial need (you must fill out the FAFSA). Special emphasis is placed on students who have exhibited business interests through work experience and/or other related activities. Applicants should also show evidence of leadership ability and other activities.

The scholarship provides \$12,500 per year and is renewable for a maximum of four years (eight semesters). Recipient must maintain a 3.25 GPA or higher on a 4.0 scale. Recipient shall work 10-12 hours per week during the academic year, or 30 hours during the summer.
