Sam M. Walton Scholarships in Business are awarded to incoming freshmen and current college students majoring in economics, finance, international business, management, or marketing at MU's Robert J. Trulaske, Sr. College of Business. Accountancy majors are not eligible for the Walton Scholarship. The primary qualifications are academic achievement & financial need (you must fill out the FAFSA). Additional consideration is given to an expressed interest in retailing. Recipients must progress toward a business degree, work parttime (10-12 hours per week) in retailing, and participate in Walton Scholar activities while attending MU. The scholarship provides \$7500 per year and is renewable for a maximum of four years (eight semesters).

Retailing involves sales to consumers—everything from inexpensive convenience items (e.g., soft drinks) to expensive durable goods (e.g., automobiles). Retailers, of course, are involved in retailing, but some manufacturers also market products directly to consumers through company-owned specialty stores, factory outlets, direct mail, or direct selling. Retailing careers include store operations & management, buying, customer relations, merchandise management, capital budgeting, training & personnel management, information systems, market research, financial management, advertising & promotions, vendor relations, traffic & transportation management, warehousing & inventory management, forecasting, and public relations.
