SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS

Most MU scholarships and grants may be used for MU sponsored or affiliated study abroad programs during a semester. They cannot be used for non-MU programs or during the summer. Tuition and non-resident scholarships may be cancelled or reduced if non-resident tuition is waived or paid by another source.

LOANS

Ford Federal Direct Loans – You must file a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to be eligible. The maximum you can receive per academic year is based on your earned credit hours: \$5,500 for students with 1-29 credits, \$6,500 for students with 30-59 credits and \$7,500 for students with 60+ credits.

Parent Federal Loans – Parents can apply for these federal loans that accrue interest on disbursement and go into repayment within 60 days. More information is available at financialaid.missouri.edu/types-of-aid/loans/loans/plus/index.php.
