

# FINANC 4820: Investment Fund Management

## Course Description and Application Instructions

The Investment Fund Management (IFM) course (FINANC 4820) introduces students to the equity research, analysis, and valuation methods used by investment professionals. Students also manage the Mizzou Investment Fund, part of the University of Missouri's endowment portfolio. The first half of the class consists of lectures. The second half of the class consists primarily of student presentations of their equity research. Students are also required to prepare and submit detailed analyst reports on their target companies. The IFM course requires a substantial time commitment and active participation in class discussion.

The class is highly recommended for students interested in pursuing careers in investment management, investment banking, or security analysis. Admission to the Mizzou IFM Program is determined through a competitive application process. The application includes the form below and two attachments:

1. A one-page (maximum) statement detailing your background and why you are interested in the IFM Program
2. A current resume
