was administered by the Missouri Incutech Foundation and Missouri Enterprise Business Assistance Center at the University of Missouri-Rolla. The grant period was 2004 through 2007. The grant provided training funds for the Advanced Manufacturing Specialist Training (AMST) Certificate Program, which included an extensive 7-week in-class training program for manufacturing, distribution, service, and educational professionals in the state of Missouri. The program took approximately 13 months to complete, and followed a 1-week in-class, 5-weeks back-at-work cycle. Participants completed three training modules, including a 2-week Lean Manufacturing session, a 2-week Business Leadership session, and a 3-week Six Sigma session. Participants completed projects in workplace and passed a certification exam for each session/module.
